ARM Industry at 29% of Goal with Six Weeks Left in Drive

No Debts for Vets Campaign Gains Momentum from New and Pre-Existing Donors

Collingswood, NJ: ARMING Heroes (www.armingheroes.org) today announced that donations from the ARM industry have enabled the organization to reach 29% of its stated goal of raising \$25,000 for military veterans by Veterans Day, Friday, November 11th. This includes funds actually received and pledges from various donors. This puts the ARM industry slightly behind the pace of donations needed to reach the goal by Veteran's Day.
